RE: National Boards Part III

The Pennsylvania State Board of Medicine states that in order to renew your Medical Training License after the completion of your first year in training in Radiation Oncology, you must show proof of having passed part III of the National Boards. Your Medical Training License will need to be renewed in April-May of the year 2003. Be aware that in order to have the results ready for your MT renewal in April of 2003 you must have taken part III of the Boards prior to December of 2002. The only other date to take the exam is in May of the year 2003, and if you take it at that time your results will not become available until after June 30, 2003. At that point, it would be too late to submit your MT renewal to the Pennsylvania State Board.

It is your responsibility to register to take part III of the National Boards. If you fail to do so or do not pass the exam, we reserve the option to reevaluate your status in our program.
